

IN A RIDESHARE WRECK? HERE'S WHAT TO DO NEXT

...IF you are a driver OR a passenger

Call 911 and seek medical attention right away for all involved. Nothing is more important than immediately making sure everyone gets the treatment they may need as soon as possible. Calling 911 also ensures that a complete police report will be filed, which could protect you later.



Passenger

- If you are physically able, take photos and video at the scene
- Get your rideshare driver's contact information and insurance information
- Get the same information from the other driver(s) involved in the crash
- Document everything else, from witness contact information to medical bills to insurance communications - you'll want to keep meticulous records
- Think about and record what could prove to be vital information, such as the speed your driver was traveling, possible distractions, etc.
- Report the matter to your insurance company - but you should wait until consulting a Farah & Farah attorney before making a recorded statement

Driver

- If you are physically able, take photos and video at the scene
- Report the accident to your rideshare company
- You do not need to contact your personal insurance - the major rideshare companies have insurance for all rides
- If another driver was at fault, you may have options to make a claim against their insurance
